Category 1 A & B Target within 4 weeks Current 6-8 weeks	Category 2 Target within 3 months Current > 2 years	Category 3 Target within 6 months Current > 3 years
<p>P1A</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Suspected testicular malignancy • Gross Haematuria • Renal Mass >4cm • Bladder lesion on imaging • Renal obstruction • Hydronephrosis <p>P1B</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rising PSA/Abnormal DRE • Renal Mass < 4cm • Single episode of resolved haematuria • Urinary Retention with IDC • Symptomatic kidney stones 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bladder Stones • Asymptomatic Renal Stone > 1cm • Complicated LUTS (bladder stones, epididymo-orchitis) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Uncomplicated LUTS (including recurrent UTI's, incontinence, nocturia) • Perineal pain • Orchalgia • Hydrocele • Asymptomatic stones (renal or ureteric)
