The Nursing and Midwifery Skills and Training Package comprises three graduate and continuing professional development programs for SA Health nurses and midwives, and is part of SA Health's strategy to build nursing and midwifery capability and capacity throughout metropolitan, regional, and rural South Australia

### What are the three programs offered within the Nursing and Midwifery Skills and Training Package?

The three programs are the Clinical Specialisation Program, ICU and HDU Upskilling Program and the Nursing and Midwifery Graduate Program.

### Who can apply?

Eligibility for each program differs. Please refer to the individual FAQs for each program.

### Who is delivering the Nursing and Midwifery Skills and Training Package?

Programs within the Nursing and Midwifery Skills and Training Package have been co-designed and delivered by leading education providers including UniSA, the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation (SA Branch), and the University of Melbourne, in partnership with SA Health.

### How much does it cost?

SA Health is covering the cost of course delivery for its current and future nursing and midwifery employees as part of the Nursing and Midwifery Skills and Training Package.
